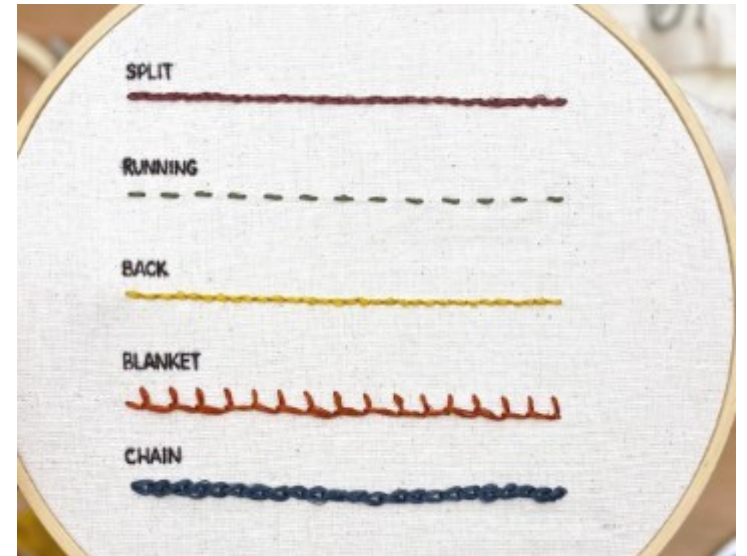

Aesthetics—How pleasing is your artwork to look at?


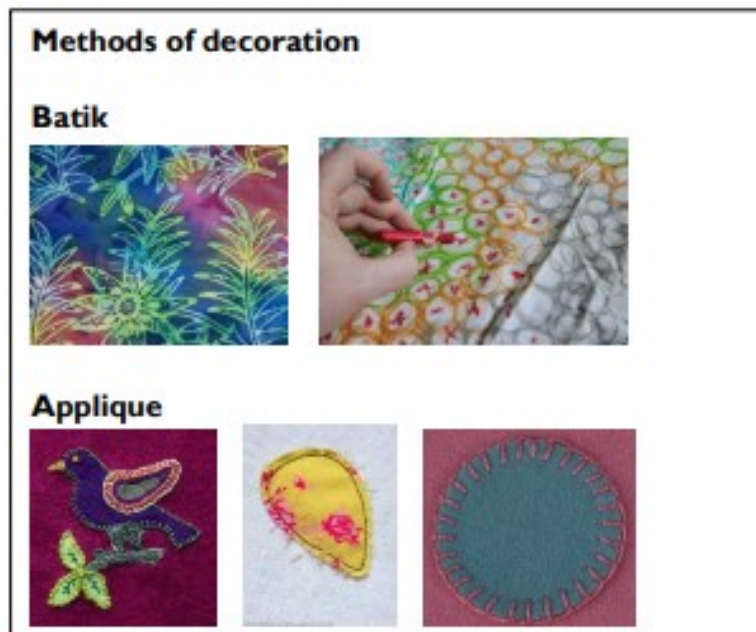
Applique—To glue or sew fabric to another piece of fabric for decoration.

Design—to create or show ideas for a final piece.


Abstract art— Simple forms, patterns and colours are used to remind us of real things.



Equipment—Fabric, scissors, needle, pins, sewing hoop, thread



Wassily Kandinsky was born in Moscow, Russia on 4th December 1866. He went to art school in Odessa, Ukraine (which was part of Russia at that time).
